





EHRs may be especially important for Wraparound and Systems of Care

- ▶ They facilitate cross-system communication.
- ➤ Youth and families can be more easily transitioned to new staff, especially important when there is high-staff turnover.
- ▶ Documentation provides additional accountability for difficult work.

We asked "deciders" to rank their motivations for moving to a new EHR system

| Reasons to choose a new EHR: | % of times chosen as top 3 reason |
|--|-----------------------------------|
| To standardize information/data collection | 77.1% |
| To make data easily available for analysis and reports | 78.6% |
| To improve continuity of care | 61.4% |
| Previous EHR was not meeting needs | 41.4% |
| Funders/payers required it | 17.1% |
| To keep up with the times/peers | 11.4% |

An EHR is not simply a piece of software. It is a transformation of your business.

Don't shop for an EHR the way you would shop for other software or IT.

Overall goals for the new system

- Storing information for all youth
 - ▶ Not just youth who were administered a tool
 - ► Allows for reporting on outcomes and demographics for entire population served
- ► All data needs in one place
 - ► Collection
 - ▶ Tracking
 - Reports
- ► Information on program
 - ► Helps us know what is working (i.e. ideal caseload, staff turnover rates)

- ► Information under these tabs will look different for users at different levels
- ► Higher-level users can see all information for any level below them



System Hierarchy

- ▶ 5 levels
 - ▶ Uber (WERT)
 - ► Collaborator (multi-organization)
 - ► **Organization** (multi-agency)
 - ► Agency (multi-site)
 - ► Site
- ► The WERT team will work with you to choose appropriate levels for your program
- Programs will operate at the lowest number of levels needed, even if titles do not match







- ► Purpose: How are you doing?
- ▶ Information and outcomes at a glance
 - ▶ Youth enrolled
 - ► Youth discharge
 - ▶ Discharge outcomes
 - ► Mean length of service
 - ► Mean fidelity
 - Snapshot of data collection
























Youth Roster



- ► Purpose: Entering youth into the system
 - ► Hosts all youth records (enrolled **and** discharged)



Youth Roster

- ▶ Data collection will be pulled from youth on this roster
- ► Includes variables on enrollment/discharge dates and discharge status
 - ► Allows for tracking of critical outcomes over time:
 - ► Length of enrollment
 - ► Overall Success of discharged youth/families



Youth roster variables

- ► Basic demographic information
 - ▶ *Youth ID
 - *Wraparound Start Date
 - ▶ Gender
 - ► Race & Ethnicity
 - **▶** DOB
 - ▶ Referral Date & Source
 - ► Legal Custodian
 - ► Contact information for Caregiver, Youth, and relevant Team Members

Youth roster variables continued

- Previous involvement with Juvenile Justice and/or Child Welfare
- ► History of expulsion/suspension from school
- History of hospitalization or residential treatment for mental health reasons
- Number of: arrests, runaways, hospitalization for MH reason, suspensions & expulsions
- ► Exit date and reason
- ► Rating of Level of Needs met

Evaluation Cycles



► Purpose:

- ► Initiates a unique fidelity evaluation project, or "cycle"
- ▶ Defines the rules for the cycle
- ► Fixed vs. ongoing cycles





Evaluation Cycles

- ► Rules for selecting youth
 - ► Cannot pick and choose who is in sample
 - ► Sample will be stratified by length of care
 - ► Can stratify by Care Coordinator
 - ► Can include discharged youth when appropriate
- Automatically pulls your random sample based on rules you set




Evaluation Cycles: Fixed vs. Ongoing Fixed Ongoing

- ► Pulls a sample of eligible youth
 - ▶ Percent of population
 - Specific number
- Number in sample remains constant
- ► Typically for larger programs with lots of youth


- ► Adds in all youth as they become eligible
 - ▶ i.e. youth added at 6 months of care
- Number in sample grows as youth are added
- Intended for smaller programs




Data Management







- ▶ Purpose: Entering data, sending emails, checking completion status
 - System internally tracks tool completion status
 - Contact information and sending forms via email both in one place
- ► Bulk invite for WFI-EZ
 - ► Can schedule messages
 - ▶ i.e. On 6/13/19 send email to all caregivers who have not completed the form

Team

Reports



- ▶ Purpose: Aid data visualization and analysis
- Example reports:
 - Demographics
 - ► Fidelity scores
 - ► Item-level means
 - ► Relative strengths and areas for improvement



Manage



- ▶ Purpose: administrative functions
- Add users
 - Administrator
 - Data Collection Manager
- Add Care Coordinators
- ► Provide information about your program
 - ► Examples: Year created, caseload size, Care Coordinator turnover rate

Manage: User Roles

Site Administrator

- Create and manage users within their site
- Update program information
- Set defaults for cycle creation & sample selection parameters per tool within site
- Create data collection cycles and enter data within their site
- View all data entered across all users within their site
- Manage facilitator roles and youth roster
- Create and view reports

Data Collection Manager

- Enter and view all data within their site
- Manage facilitator roles and youth roster
- Create and view reports
